

## **Application for Individual Work (POS 4905)**

Before you may register for an individual work course, in consultation with his/her supervising faculty member, the student must attach to this form a brief description of his/her proposed research, as well as a list of readings and other materials that will be examined. This statement must be approved by the supervising faculty member and the Undergraduate Coordinator, Professor Richard Nolan. It is assumed that the quality of academic work will be appropriate for a 3-credit course.

You can receive credit for the major only once for enrolling in POS 4905. POS 4905 may be used for students doing internships through the Washington Center.

To register for POS 4095:

- 1) Attach a brief description of proposed research to this form (as described above).
- 2) Send the form to the supervising faculty member for his/her signature.
- 3) Send the form to Professor Nolan (<u>rnolan@ufl.edu</u>) for his approval.
- 4) Take the form (with all approvals and proposals) back to the Political Science department, 234 Anderson Hall to the Academic Assistant III. If all is in order, you will be registered for the course. Under no circumstances will the section number be given out of the office without all approvals and the attached proposal.
